## **South Sound Lacrosse (SSL)**

## **Field Marshall Program**

<u>Goal</u> – To help ensure a safe and good sportsman-like environment that exemplifies the "Honor the Game" slogan and to improve SSL in alignment with Code of Conduct.

<u>Objective</u> – To monitor, marshal and report inappropriate behavior including but not limited to; derogatory language, taunting, any form of Referee intimidation, swearing, excessive yelling (as opposed to rooting), and/or aggressive behavior towards others.

## **Duties**

- One Marshal must be provided <u>from each team every game</u>.
- Attend the pre-game meeting to get <u>Florescent Vest</u> and meet other teams Marshal.
- Meet Score Table and Referees Staff
- Discuss how to work with Referees.
- Work with the <u>Home Team Coach</u> to put out <u>End-line Balls</u> out before, during and after the game.
- Help ensure only <u>coaches with Lanyards</u>, <u>players</u>, <u>referees</u>, <u>and the table staff</u> are on the Bench-side.
- Ask <u>spectators</u> to move to <u>opposite side</u> of the Bench if they are sitting on the wrong side – unless in a separate fenced stadium area.
- Ensure parent chairs and other objects are at least 3 yards off the field sideline.
- Warn parents, fans, or anyone spectating of inappropriate behavior and refer them to the Code of Conduct.
- Notify Referee after giving a 2nd Warning to someone;
  - ONLY DURING A DEAD-BALL i.e. after a whistle, during penalties, time outs, half time, etc.
- After game is over <u>return vest</u> and help Score Table work team if needed.
